






#### What We Do

#### **Good Stewards of Your Tax Dollars**


- MarionCountyFireDistrict1

### **Balanced Budget: Revenue**


- FY 2020 Revenue Summary: \$17,851,839
  - Property Taxes \$9,417,637
  - Beginning Fund Balance \$5,768,702
  - Ambulance Transport Billing \$1,975,000
  - Other \$690,500

### **Balanced Budget: Expenses**



- FY 2020 Expense Summary: \$17,851,839
  - Personnel \$9,496,395
  - Materials & Services \$2,269,926
  - Ending Fund Balance \$2,243,296
  - Reserves \$1,937,364
  - Debt Service \$940,137
  - Contingency \$585,000
  - Capital Outlay \$254,722
  - Transfers \$125,000

# PROTECT & SERVE E315


Emergency services are funded through:

- Permanent property tax rate of \$1.90 per \$1,000 of assessed property value
- Operations levy of 71-cents per \$1,000 of assessed property value
- Also have two bonds for apparatus, equipment and facilities
  - Will retire in 2022 and 2024




Historically Low Level of Volunteers

#### Response Times Too...And, We Have a Plan to Respond



- Strategic Plan in place
  - Respond to higher call volumes
    - 5.3% increase on average each year
  - Address increasing response times
- Plan calls for hiring additional personnel to respond to these needs
  - Includes back-to-back emergencies
    - 55% of our calls
    - Can take 11 minutes for help to arrive - our goal is 7 minutes or less
  - Often in these cases, we have to rely on mutual aid from neighboring agencies
    - Takes longer to reach you



# **Strategic Plan**

- The Plan also identifies future capital needs, which include:
  - Replacing apparatus and equipment

  - Savings for taxpayers

Your Support Means We Are Prepared for Any Emergency



- Prior to the pandemic, the fire district was asking voters to increase its operating levy from 71 to 99 cents during the May 2020 Primary Election
- This 28-cent increase would cost \$4.67 per month for the owner of a \$200,000 home
  - Or \$56 per year
- This will fund:
  - Two firefighter/paramedics to respond to increasing call volumes
  - Apparatus and equipment replacement
  - And, now backfill costs associated with COVID-19 for personal protective gear and temporary personnel

#### Without Levy Increase



- Reduction in services
- Increased response times
- Reliance on mutual aid for basic call volumes
- Reduction in personnel
- Decreased staffed response apparatus


