

- Long history of passing its financial audits



We Want Our Community to Know How Emergency Services are Funded.





- Emergency services are funded through:
 - Permanent property tax rate of \$1.90 per \$1,000 of assessed property value
 - Until last year, we also received a local option levy of \$0.71 per \$1,000.
 - Not renewed by voters
 - Loss of 30 percent or \$2.4 million to provide emergency services
- Independent Special District
 - No funding from any city, Marion County Government or the State of Oregon

Current Staffing Levels are Unsafe for the Public and Its Firefighters.




Losing revenue from the local option levy resulted in:

- Permanently closing two fire stations
- Laying off 12 firefighter/paramedics
- Reducing the number of staffed emergency apparatus from 5 1/2 to 3 units
- It's taking us longer to reach you in an emergency
- When responding to calls, firefighters may only be able to fight a fire from outside the building versus an interior attack
 - Puts lives and property at greater risk
- At times, like during the recent ice storm, there are no emergency units available to respond to calls.

Call Volumes Have Increased 50% in Eight Years.






Response Times Are Getting Longer.


• Up 1 minute and 4 seconds over last 12 months





Seconds Matter in an Emergency.


• Success-Time Cardiac Curve






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




Staffing Stations – Pre-July 1, 2020 With Local Option Levy

We Need More Full-time Emergency Personnel to Respond to Calls.

- Asking voters to approve a local option levy
 - May 18, 2021 District Election
- The levy would:
 - Last for five years
 - Cost \$59 yearly (\$4.92 a month) per \$100,000 of your home's assessed value
 - Assessed value is typically lower than
 its market value








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Local Option Levy





- Filling nine of the 12 emergency responder positions that were cut
 - Due to revenue losses
- Placing a dedicated and fully staffed fire engine in service
 - 24 hours a day/7 days a week
